## Angkasa solar project rakes in RM5,000 a month

KUALA LUMPUR, March 25 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian National Co-operative Movement's (Angkasa) solar project in Sungai Tiang, Pendang, Kedah has generated a monthly income of RM5,000 since it started operations on Jan 1, 2018.

Its President, Datuk Abdul Fattah Abdullah, said the project, operating on a 1.2-hectare (ha) solar farm, generated 4.9 kilowatts (kWh) of solar energy daily.

"The reason why we picked to have the operations in Sungai Tiang is due to a better sunlight penetration rate in the northern states.

"We will supply the solar energy to Tenaga Nasional Bhd on a 21-month contract which has been approved by Sustainable Energy Development Authority Malaysia," he told reporters at Angkasa's Federal Territories Conference here today.

The renewable solar energy project was part of Angkasa's activities where it hoped to call on co-operativesto invest in the solar business soon.

Angkasa has invested RM9 million to develop the Sungai Tiang solar project and was set to reap profits for the movement in the long run.

"At present, the project is being carried out on 0.35 ha. It is expected to generate a yearly income of RM1.35 million," he said.
