## **Angkasa Wants To Be On NCOLAC Council**

IPOH, Dec 10 (Bernama) -- Angkatan Koperasi Kebangsaan Malaysia Berhad (Angkasa) has offered to become a committee member of the National Cost of Living Action Council (NCOLAC) , which is due to be set up to ease the burden of the people in facing the cost of living.

Angkasa president Datuk Abdul Fattah Abdullah said the umbrella body for cooperatives supported the setting up of NCOLAC, which was announced by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak during the winding up session of the 2017 UMNO General Assembly yesterday.

"We hope to become a committee member of the council because cost of living is not only in terms of food but we also look at other areas, including transportation, housing and others," he told reporters here today.

Najib, who is also UMNO president, had approved the setting up of NCOLAC which was suggested by UMNO Youth representative Jamawi Jaafar at the assembly.

When debating the motion on economy yesterday, Jamawi, who is UMNO Youth Information chief, suggested that the council be set up to help overcome the problem of cost of living, middlemen and sabotage of the national economy.
