## **IBR: MACC Praises ANGKASA's Determination**

PETALING JAYA, July 17 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) has praised the sincerity demonstrated by Angkatan Koperasi Kebangsaan Malaysian Berhad (ANGKASA) in signing the Corruption-Free Pledge (IBR) today to ensure that the agency's administration is free from corruption and abuse of power.

MACC Deputy Chief Commissioner (Prevention) Datuk Shamsun Baharin Mohd Jamil said this initiative by ANGKASA showed the agency's seriousness in addressing corruption.

"The MACC sees the sincerity and the seriousness of ANGKASA in combating corruption because the agency itself has set up an integrity unit that ensures every employee is corruption-free."

"In addition, ANGKASA has also sent four of its officers to attend the one-month Certified Integrity Officer (CeIO) course which is managed by MACC itself ... agencies that have not signed the IBR can emulate ANGKASA," he told reporters after witnessing the IBR signing ceremony by Angkasa here, today.

At the event, ANGKASA president Datuk Abdul Fattah Abdullah led more than 200 staff members to recite the pledge.
