Angkasa Allocates RM10 Million For Another 10 Dialysis Centres

TEMERLOH, July 4 (Bernama) -- Angkatan Koperasi Kebangsaan Malaysia Berhad (Angkasa) has allocated RM10 million to open another 10 MyAngkasa Dialysis Centres nationwide in 2020.

Angkasa president Abdul Datuk Fattah Abdullah said the availability of dialysis centres in each state would help underprivileged patients to get cheaper treatment, with transportation service and food provided.

"To date Angkasa has four dialysis centres, in Alor Setar, Kuching, Temerloh and Johor Bahru, which involved an allocation of RM4 million.

"The additional of dialysis centres are needed since a research found an increase of 3,000 new kidney patients each year," he told reporters at the Angkasa Pahang Zone 2 Aidilfitri celebration, here today.

He said Temerloh MyAngkasa Dialysis Centre was the first dialysis centre wholly-owned by Angkasa in Malaysia which offered dialysis service to 30 patients over three shifts per day.
