# CALLING PHOTO BUFFS

**T**HE National Co-operative Movement of Malaysia (Angkasa) and the New Straits Times Press (NSTP) Co-operative are organising the ICAKL Photography 2017 (Fotografi ICAKL 2017) competition.

The contest, to be held from

June 18 to July 22, is open to all Malaysians, as well as participants from other countries.

Those who want to take part in the contest should "like" and "share" Angkasa's official Facebook page, and the "Fotografi ICAKL 2017" page.

Contestants must be aged 18 and above. This is the first internationally organised programme.

Angkasa president Datuk Abdul Fattah Abdullah said the competition was to promote Angkasa as the host for the International Co-operative Alliance (ICA) Global Conference and General Assembly 2017 programme, which will be held in Kuala Lumpur in November.

"Participants must upload their photos to the Fotografi ICAKL 2017 Facebook page.

"The photos will be evaluated on their originality, concept and idea suitable to the theme (Putting People at the Centre of Development), composition, creativity and uniqueness," he said at the launch of the contest at its headquarters here yesterday.

Present were Angkasa deputy president Mutadho Bahri, NSTP Co-operative chairman Mohd Fadzil Abd Ghani and NSTP Government Unit Advertisement manager Mohammad Anis Abdullah.

Participants must submit at least three photos in JPEG format, with a resolution of 300dpi

and sizes not more than 500KB. However, only one photo will be evaluated to win the competition.

Each photo sent must have a caption not more than 30 words in Bahasa Melayu or English, and include the hashtag #ICAKL2017.

The top winner will walk away

with cash prizes worth RM2,500, the second place winner will take home RM1,500, while the third place winner will receive RM1,000.

The winners in fourth and fifth places will receive RM700 and RM500 respectively. The eight consolation prizes will be RM100 each.
