Angkasa Identifies Location For Second Solar Panel Project In Kedah

YAN, Oct 21 (Bernama) -- Angkatan Koperasi Kebangsaan Malaysia Berhad (Angkasa) has identified several potential locations in Kedah for implementing the second solar panel project.

Its president, Datuk Abdul Fattah Abdullah said among the locations under consideration were Sungai Petani and Jitra.

"We have implemented the solar panel pilot project at Sungai Tiang, Pendang where construction work started early last year and is expected to be completed later this year, before commencing operations in early 2018.

"The project is entirely under Angkasa, but for the second phase, Angkasa is ready to consider and work with cooperatives under our auspices who are keen to participate," he said.

He was speaking to Bernama after opening the 36th General Meeting of Co-operative Sabena Berhad 2017/2018 at Kampung Acheh here today.

Abdul Fattah said, the solar panel pilot project at Sungai Tiang costing about RM10 million for 1 Megawatt, is expected to generate about RM200,000 a month, He said they had chosen Kedah for the implementation of the project as the state was seen as the best location due to the high amount of sunlight it receives.
